YOUR SERVICES INCLUDE

Twice a Week Trash: Your trash can and up to two plastic bags. No container shall weigh more than sixty (60) pounds and shall be in good repair.

Once a Week Recycling: Limited to 64-gallon recycling cart

Yard Waste Limits: 3 trash cans or 6-yardwaste bags per household. Limbs and trunks must be less than four (4) inches in diameter, 48 inches in length and tied and bundled not weighing more than 75 pounds per bundle. **NO PLASTIC BAGS!**

Bulk Pick Up: The City of Valley Park provides big trash pick-up once a year at no additional charge.

All residents within the City of Valley Park are required to have sanitation service. Property owners of rental property are responsible for all sanitation bills.

Sanitation is billed (\$69) quarterly.

20 Main St (Valley Park School Bus Parking Lot)
47 Marshall Rd (Meramec Valley Plaza)

Accepted Recycling:

- Containers – steel, tin, and aluminum
- Plastic- number 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 7 on the container
NO PLASTIC BAGS OR MOTOR OIL CONTAINERS
- Aluminum – foil/tray
- Newspaper – (clean & dry) with inserts, magazines, telephone books and pressed fiber cardboard such as cereal boxes
- Cardboard must be broken down and bundled in 2-inch bundles for collection at the curb.
- Mixed paper – office papers, junk mail, paper bags and all other paper
All paper goods must be dry
- Aseptic/Gable Top Containers – milk & juice cartons

Remember: Empty, Clean and Dry!



If it is not listed, please leave it out!

What Cannot Be Recycled

Plastic grocery bags, plastic film, sheets or wrap, paper towels, napkins/tissues, styrofoam, and pizza boxes

Items not accepted for disposal include- antifreeze, batteries, car parts, freon, propane tanks, gas tanks, asphalt, concrete, oil, paint, mixed yard and household waste, and building materials

CITY OBSERVED HOLIDAYS
